TARGET AUDIENCE:

LEVEL OF TRAINING ACTIVITY: Basic – Advanced



OBJECTIVES:

- Learning how to build and operate a virtual hospital.
- Acquiring new capabilities and knowledge of telehealth services.
- Enhancing small-scale \ local telehealth pilots or initiatives into scaled-up services.



MAIN TOPICS: (up to 10)

- Remote / Hybrid Chronic disease management
- Multidisciplinary online rehabilitation
- Remote cardiac rehabilitation
- Home hospitalization
- Remote physician consultancy services



TYPE OF ACTIVITY

- Offsite observership at Sheba – Individual
- Offsite training course at Sheba – Multiple participants
- Onsite "visiting experts" from Sheba at the hosting site
- Digital training course – Multiple participants



TRAINING METHODOLOGY:

- Lectures (face-to-face or remote) (dependent on the chosen activity)
- Clinical case discussions
- Journal club
- Real-time, online live case observation



NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS:

- Offsite observership at Sheba: 1-4
- Offsite training course at Sheba: 10-15
- Onsite "visiting experts" from Sheba at the hosting site: 2
- Digital training course: 30-40



DURATION:

- Offsite observership at Sheba - 2 days
- Offsite training course at Sheba - 1 week
- Onsite "visiting experts" from Sheba at the hosting site - 2 days
- Digital training course - 6 weekly sessions of 4 academic hours each (Total 24 Academic hours)

*One academic hour comprises a 45-minute lecture.
